AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$27,000.00 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE "FWC") CONSERVATION COMMISSION (THE FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE'S COSTS TO REMOVE THREE DERELICT VESSELS IN CITY JACKSONVILLE WATERWAYS, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 21-096; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT, ENVIRONMENTAL OUALITY DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

 - The funding above represents an appropriation of \$27,000.00

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in grant funding from the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (the "FWC") for reimbursement to the City of the costs to remove three derelict vessels located in City waterways.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to appropriate \$27,000.00 in grant funding from the FWC to the City to cover the City's costs for removal of three (3) derelict vessels located in the public waterways within the jurisdiction of the City. Pursuant to that certain Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission Agreement No. 20367 between FWC and the City ("Contract #20367"), the FWC will reimburse the City up to \$17,000.00 for removal of a 34 foot home-built sailboat and a 21 foot Arrowgls speedboat, both of which are located in the Trout River. A copy of Contract #20367 is On File with the Office of Legislative Services.

In addition, pursuant to the terms and conditions of that certain Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission Agreement No. 20377 between the FWC and the City ("Contract #20377"), the FWC will reimburse the City up to \$10,000.00 for removal of a 27 foot Hunter Marine Sailboat located in the intracoastal waterway north of the Beach Boulevard bridge. A copy of Contract #20377 is **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services.

Section 3. Oversight. The Environmental Quality Division of the Neighborhoods Department shall provide oversight of the project described herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
