Approval and Authorization.

There is hereby

in accordance with Section 111.365, Ordinance Code, and a transfer of \$7,500.00 from the Fund to the Police Explorers Trust Fund for the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office Police Explorer Post, in accordance with Section 111.340, Ordinance Code. This funding also includes \$200,000.00 to purchase and install security fencing at various Jacksonville Sheriff's Office facilities.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide donations to the following organizations, in the stated amounts: North Florida Council, Inc., Boy Scouts of America (\$10,000.00), The Parent Help Center, Inc. (\$20,000.00), First Coast Inc. (\$23,000.00), Florida Crime Stoppers, Prevention (\$1,000.00), and the Association Incorporated National Enforcement Memorial and Museum (\$1,000.00). This allocation supports drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, and/or school resource officer programs for the citizens of the City of Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida. A Certification from the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office that the subject appropriation from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.
