A FINAL ASSESSMENT ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 170, FLORIDA STATUTES, AND CHAPTERS 491 AND 715, ORDINANCE CODE, FOR SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR FLORIDA AGENCY FOR HEALTHCARE ADMINISTRATION ("AHCA") LICENSED HOSPITALS PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE 2021-552-E; ESTABLISHING THE 2021 ASSESSMENT RATE; APPROVING THE 2021 FINAL ASSESSMENT ROLL AND ESTABLISHING THE METHOD OF COLLECTION; RETAINING RIGHTS GRANTED BY CHAPTER 170, FLORIDA STATUTES; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

and 170.08, Florida Statutes, as well as Chapter 491 and Section 715.206, Ordinance Code, the Council held a public hearing on September 28, 2021, to hear testimony from affected property owners as to the propriety and advisability of funding the proposed improvements described in Initial Assessment Ordinance 2021-552-E through special assessments on the subject properties, including a preliminary roll, as described therein, and met as an equalizing board to hear and consider any and all complaints as to the special assessments. The Council hereby confirms Initial Assessment Ordinance 2021-552-E and approves the assessment rate as established in Initial Assessment Ordinance 2021-552-E. Proof of mailing the notices required by Section 170.07, Florida Statutes, and Section 715.205, Ordinance Code, is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and

incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Assessment Roll and Method of Collection. The Council hereby approves the 2021 Assessment Roll attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The method of collection for 2021 shall be the alternative method pursuant to Chapter 170, Florida Statutes. Pursuant to Section 170.08, Florida Statutes, the 2021 Assessment Roll shall be recorded in the City of Jacksonville Improvement Lien Book.

Section 3. Retaining All Rights Granted by Chapter 170, Florida Statutes. The City of Jacksonville hereby retains all rights granted to municipalities by Chapter 170, Florida Statutes, for the special assessments authorized herein, including priority of lien, interest and foreclosure; provided, however, that any legal proceeding to enforce payment of such special assessments shall require City Council approval.

passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the anticipated due date from AHCA for payment of the local share of the Medicaid shortfall funded through these special assessments will be October 31, 2021, which requires implementation of the assessment and receipt of payments by the City prior to that date.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
