## 1 Introduced by the Council President at the Request of the Mayor:

ORDINANCE 2021-583-E 4 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE 5 6 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION 7 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, THAT CERTAIN 8 DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIVE COVENANT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT 9 OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, TO PLACE LAND USE 10 RESTRICTIONS ON PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE PINE 11 12 FOREST POND FACILITY, LOCATED NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF GRANT ROAD AND JOHNSON AVENUE, 13 JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA (R.E. NUMBERS 147419-14 0000, 147524-0000, 147524-0010, 147522-0000, 15 147523-0000, and 147517-00000), AND ANY OTHER 16 DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSES 17 OF THE RESTRICTIVE COVENANT; PROVIDING AN 18 EFFECTIVE DATE. 19

WHEREAS, environmental contamination from the deposit of subsurface debris, consisting mostly of household trash, on the property currently occupied by the City's Pine Forest Pond facility located near the intersection of Grant Road and Johnson Avenue, (R.E. numbers 147419-0000, 147524-0000, 147524-0010, 147522-0000, 147523-0000, and 147517-0000) has been remediated; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) has agreed to regulatory closure of the site pending the approval and placement of a Declaration of Restrictive Covenant (DRC) on the property; and

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WHEREAS, the DRC imposes land use restrictions at the site; and

WHEREAS, one of the final steps in completing the remediation process is the execution of the DRC, which will then allow the City to obtain the Site Rehabilitation Completion Order with Conditions from FDEP; now therefore

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Approval and authorization. There is hereby Section 1. 6 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary 7 are hereby authorized to execute and deliver that certain Declaration 8 9 of Restrictive Covenant between the City of Jacksonville and Florida Department of Environmental Protection, in substantially the same 10 form placed **ON FILE** with the Office of Legislative Services, and any 11 other documents necessary to effectuate the purposes of the DRC, so 12 as to allow the City to place land use restrictions on the site. 13

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
