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1 Introduced by the Council President at the request of the Mayor:

ORDINANCE 2021-659-E 4 5 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE TO JOIN WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA 6 7 AND OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL UNITS AS 8 PARTICIPANT IN THE FLORIDA MEMORANDUM OF 9 UNDERSTANDING AND FORMAL AGREEMENTS IMPLEMENTING A UNIFIED PLAN; REQUESTING ONE 10 CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE 11 12 DATE.

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WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville has suffered harm from the 15 opioid epidemic; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville recognizes that the entire 16 State of Florida has suffered harm as a result from the opioid 17 18 epidemic; and

19 WHEREAS, the State of Florida has filed an action pending in 20 Pasco County, Florida, and a number of Florida Cities and Counties 21 have also filed an action In re: National Opiate Litigation, MDL No. 22 2804 (N.D. Ohio) (the "Opioid Litigation") and the City of 23 Jacksonville is a litigating participant in that action; and

24 WHEREAS, the State of Florida and lawyers representing certain 25 various local governments involved in the Opioid Litigation have 26 proposed a unified plan for the allocation and use of prospective 27 settlement dollars from opioid related litigation; and

28 WHEREAS, the Florida Memorandum of Understanding (the "Florida 29 Plan") sets forth a framework of a unified plan for the proposed allocation and use of opioid settlement proceeds and it is anticipated 30 that formal agreements implementing the Florida Plan will be entered 31

1 into at a future date; and

2 WHEREAS, participation in the Florida Plan by a large majority 3 of Florida cities and counties will materially increase the amount 4 of funds to Florida and should improve Florida's relative bargaining 5 position during additional settlement negotiations; and

6 WHEREAS, failure to participate in the Florida Plan will reduce 7 funds available to the State, the City of Jacksonville, and every 8 other Florida city and county; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

10 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to 11 support a unified plan for the allocation and use of opioid settlement 12 proceeds as generally described in the Florida Plan, attached hereto 13 as Exhibit 1.

Approval of the Florida Plan; Authorization to 14 Section 2. Execute and Implement. The Council hereby approves, and the Mayor, 15 or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary, are hereby authorized 16 17 to execute, for and on behalf of the City of Jacksonville, the Florida Plan in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit 1, and to 18 19 take, or cause to be taken, for and on behalf of the City, such 20 further action as is necessary to effectuate the purpose of this 21 Ordinance.

22 Section 3. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant 23 to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this 24 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that on 25 August 13, 2021, the State of Florida set a deadline of September 30, 26 2021, for passage of this legislation.

27 Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 29 without the Mayor's signature.
