9 THE CITY) TO PURCHASE ONE (1) 37' ALUMINUM,  
10 OPEN-OCEAN AND INSHORE, CBRNE CAPABLE FIRE  
11 SUPPRESSION HAZMAT RESPONSE BOAT, AS INITIATED  
12 BY B.T. 22-009; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION;  
13 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND  
14 RESCUE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.  
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16 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

17 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,  
18 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
19 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
20 listed in subsection (b):

28 The funding above represents an appropriation of  
29 \$337,500.00 in Fire And Rescue Grant funding from the  
30 Department of Homeland Security/Port Security Grant  
31 Program distributed by the Department of Homeland Security

1 / Federal Department of Emergency Management and funded  
2 through the Department of Homeland Security / Federal  
3 Department of Emergency Management FY2021 Port Security  
4 Grant Program and an additional appropriation of  
5 \$112,500.00 from the City. These funds will be used to  
6 assist the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department with  
7 purchasing one aluminum, open-ocean and inshore, CBRNE  
8 capable fire suppression hazmat response boat. The grant  
9 period commences September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2024.

10 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
11 Section 1 is to support the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department  
12 with purchasing one aluminum, open-ocean and inshore, CBRNE capable  
13 fire suppression hazmat response boat. A copy of the Federally-  
14 Funded FY2021 Port Security Grant Program (Grant Number: EMW-2021-  
15 PU-00446) providing the terms and conditions relative to receipt and  
16 expenditure of the grant funds has been placed **On File** with the Office  
17 of Legislative Services.

18 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue  
19 Department, Emergency Preparedness Division shall oversee  
20 administration of the grant described herein.

21 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
23 without the Mayor's signature.
