Explanation of Appropriation: (C)

> The appropriation above represents an award \$1,000,000.00 in discretionary non-competitive funds from the State of Florida Department of Education for the City of Jacksonville's Northwest Jacksonville STEM Center for Teens (the "STEM Center") for the period commencing July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. No City match is required.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund the procurement of furniture and fixtures, computer hardware and software, and educational supplies for the STEM In addition, the funds will be used to procure the professional services of 100 Black Men of Jacksonville, Inc. and I'm A Star Foundation, Inc. who will manage the STEM Center and provide STEM industry training and hi-tech programs at the STEM Center in the evenings and on weekends. The overall purpose of the STEM Center is to provide workforce training, academic enrichment and positive youth development. Training and programs funded by these State dollars

will target at-risk youth ages 12 to 18 years from several Title 1 schools and neighborhoods located near the STEM Center. In addition, the STEM Center will provide programming that targets young adults ages 19 to 21 years through the Mayor's Youth at Work Partnership Program. Documentation reflecting the initial State of Florida appropriation of funds for the STEM Center in fiscal year 2019-2020, including the notice of award and Request for Application (RFA Discretionary) terms and conditions applicable to use of the funds, as well as a copy of the relevant portions of State of Florida Senate Bill 2500 reappropriating these funds for the STEM Center for fiscal year 2021-2022, are attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Amending Revised Schedule M to Ordinance 2020-511-E. There is hereby amended for the fiscal year 2021-2022 budget for Kids Hope Alliance ("KHA") by substituting in the place of the Revised Schedule M, approved by Ordinance 2021-511-E, the Second Revised Schedule M, attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 3, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 3, 2nd Rev Schedule M, October 4, 2021 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. The Second Revised Schedule M reflects the funds appropriated herein.

Section 4. Approval and Authorization to Execute Agreements with 100 Black Men of Jacksonville, Inc. and I'm A Star Foundation, Inc. The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary, and/or the Chief Executive Officer of KHA, are hereby authorized to execute and deliver an agreement between KHA and 100 Black Men of Jacksonville, Inc. in a not to exceed amount of \$200,000.00, and an agreement between KHA and I'm A Star Foundation, Inc. in a not to exceed amount of \$200,000.00, for the provision of professional services at the STEM Center, to include management of the STEM Center and providing STEM industry training and hi-tech programs, as more particularly described in Exhibit 4, attached hereto and incorporated

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2021 through June 30, 2022, with up to two (2) one (1) year renewal The agreements may include such extensions, renewals, options. additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, and/or the Chief Executive Officer of KHA, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by the execution of the agreements by the Mayor, or his designee, and/or the Chief Executive Officer of the Kids Hope Alliance; provided, however, no modifications to the agreements may increase the financial obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amounts stated in the agreements or decrease the duties and obligations of 100 Black Men of Jacksonville, Inc. or I'm A Star Foundation, Inc., and any such modifications shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel and the Office of Risk Management for appropriate insurance and indemnification terms. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "tenchical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City or any other nonsubstantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and

Section 5. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. KHA is hereby authorized to procure professional services from 100 Black Men of Jacksonville, Inc. and I'm A Star Foundation, Inc. for the provision of services described in Exhibit 4, as authorized in Section 4 above. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such services are exempted from competitive solicitation because the services to be provided are being approved via authorizing legislation pursuant to this Ordinance.

Section 6. Waiver of the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids

Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance Code. The City hereby waives the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance Code, with respect to the contracts with 100 Black Men of Jacksonville, Inc. and I'm A Star Foundation, Inc. approved and authorized in Section 4 of this Ordinance. Section 77.111(a) requires contracts for children's services provided by third parties to be competitively procured by KHA via an evaluated bid process. This waiver is needed in order to allow KHA to directly contract with 100 Black Men of Jacksonville, Inc. and I'm A Star Foundation, Inc. to manage the STEM Center and provide the training and program services described in Exhibit 4.

Section 7. Oversight Department. Kids Hope Alliance shall oversee administration and disbursement of the State funds, the agreements authorized by this Ordinance, and all programming at the STEM Center.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
