AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE PROPOSED OCTOBER 1, 2021 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2024 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND LABORERS' INTERNATIONAL UNION OF NORTH AMERICA (LIUNA), REPRESENTING APPROXIMATELY 300 MEMBERS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Collective 13 Section 1. Proposed Bargaining Agreement 14 between the City of Jacksonville and LIUNA approved. That certain proposed October 1, 2021 - September 30, 2024 Collective Bargaining 15 City of Jacksonville and 16 Agreement between the Laborers' 17 International Union of North America (LIUNA), a copy of which has been placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services, is hereby 18 19 approved. LIUNA represents approximately 300 members. The proposed 20 LIUNA agreement has been agreed to in collective bargaining and has 21 been ratified by the union membership. Pursuant to the American 22 Rescue Plan, from which funds are being used for premium pay 23 associated with the Collectively Bargaining Agreements, the City has 24 made a general determination that premium pay will not increase the 25 average annual wage at the City above 150 percent of the state or 26 county's average annual wage. Further, the City considers all 27 government employees at the City to be performing critical and 28 essential functions necessary to meet the needs of the Citizens of 29 Jacksonville. One time premium payments and wage increases collectively bargained recognize the extraordinary efforts the men 30 and women of the City performed and continue to perform during the 31

2 Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance and all elements 3 of the LIUNA Collective Bargaining Agreement shall become effective 4 upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the 5 Mayor's signature.
