AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE PROPOSED OCTOBER 1, 2021 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2024 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE COMMUNICATIONS WORKERS OF AMERICA (CWA), REPRESENTING APPROXIMATELY 420 MEMBERS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

13 Section 1. Proposed Collective Bargaining Agreement 14 between the City of Jacksonville and CWA approved. That certain 15 proposed October 1, 2021 - September 30, 2024 Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the Communications 16 17 Workers of America (CWA), a copy of which has been placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services, is hereby approved. CWA 18 represents approximately 420 members. The proposed CWA agreement has 19 20 been agreed to in collective bargaining and has been ratified by the 21 union membership. Pursuant to the American Rescue Plan, from which 22 funds are being used for premium pay associated with the Collectively 23 Bargaining Agreements, the City has made a general determination that 24 premium pay will not increase the average annual wage at the City 150 percent of the state or county's average annual 25 above 26 wage. Further, the City considers all government employees at the 27 City to be performing critical and essential functions necessary to meet the needs of the Citizens of Jacksonville. One time premium 28 29 payments and wage increases collectively bargained recognize the extraordinary efforts the men and women of the City performed and 30 continue to perform during the COVID-19 pandemic. 31
