AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE PROPOSED OCTOBER 1, 2021 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2024 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE (FOP), REPRESENTING APPROXIMATELY 2,500 MEMBERS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Collective Section 1. Proposed Bargaining Agreements between the City of Jacksonville and FOP approved. Those certain proposed October 1, 2021 - September 30, 2024 Collective Bargaining Agreements between the City of Jacksonville and the Fraternal Order of Police (FOP), copies of which have been placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services, are hereby approved. FOP represents approximately 2,500 members with four collective bargaining agreements comprising FOP Corrections and Police units. The proposed FOP agreements have been agreed to in collective bargaining and have been ratified by the union membership. Pursuant to the American Rescue Plan, from which funds are being used for premium pay associated with the Collectively Bargaining Agreements, the City has made a general determination that premium pay will not increase the average annual wage at the City above 150 percent of the state or county's average annual wage. Further, the City considers all government employees at the City to be performing critical and essential functions necessary to meet the needs of the Citizens of Jacksonville. One time premium payments and wage increases collectively bargained recognize the extraordinary efforts the men

and women of the City performed and continue to perform during the
