

**NCSPHS AMENDMENT**

The Neighborhoods, Community Services, Public Health and Safety Committee offers the following amendment to File 2021-754:

(1) On **page 1, line 5**, after "ORDINANCE" **insert** "APPROPRIATING \$2,447,000 PLACED BELOW THE LINE PENDING FINAL CONTRACT FROM CONTINGENCY FOR FLORIDA-GEORGIE GAME TO SPECIAL EVENT CONTRIBUTION FOR THE ANNUAL FLORIDA-GEORGIA FOOTBALL GAME;"

(2) On **page 1, line 22**, **insert** new Sections 1 and 2 to read as follows:

**"Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(The account information is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**, and incorporated herein by this reference)

(c) **Explanation of Appropriation** - The funding above is being appropriated from contingency for Florida-Georgie game to special event contribution for the annual Florida-Georgia football game for the Annual Florida-Georgia Football Game and represents funding

that was placed below the line during the budget process pending the negotiation of the final compensation contract with the two schools.

**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide \$2,447,000 in funding for the Annual Florida-Georgia Football Game that was placed below the line in the budget process pending final contract. The final terms of the contract have been negotiated and the additional funding is needed to pay the schools compensation pursuant to the Agreement.”;

- (3) Add **Exhibit 1** attached hereto, which attaches a BT for the appropriation of \$2,447,000 placed below the line pending final contract;
- (4) Renumber remaining sections accordingly;
- (5) On **page 1, line 1**, amend the introductory sentence to add that the bill was amended as reflected herein.
