The subject legislation:

a) Approves a Redevelopment Agreement substantially in the form attached providing incentives for the redevelopment of the 18.34 acre Florida Times Union property with multi-family residential, commercial-retail and mixed-use development, the terms of which are summarized more fully in the Term Sheet attached to DIA Resolution 2021-08-01; and b) Authorizes the purchase by the City, as part of the McCoys Creek CIP project, approximately 4.6 acres of uplands and submerged lands within the 18.34 acre parcel to accommodate the relocation of McCoy's Creek thereby facilitating completion of the McCoy's Creek flood control, creek restoration and resiliency project using funds already appropriated for that project;

c) Authorizes the payment of an additional supplemental purchase price for the referenced 4.6 acres, the combined total equaling appraised value, upon demolition of the current structure and clearing of a title issue near the edge of the site allowing full use of the site for a future park;

d) Expands public view and access corridors to and from the St. Johns River and Riverside Avenue;

e) Grants a deviation from 656.361.6.2.H.2(b) to authorize an increase to the maximum distance between the inside of the River View and Access Corridors from 250' to approximately 350'; and,

f) Waiving Chapter 656 (Zoning Code), Part 3 (Schedule of District Regulations), Subpart H (Downtown Overlay Zone and Downtown District Use and Form Regulations), Section 656.361.8 (Deviations) A (General Considerations), Section 656.361.8.A.3., Section 656.361.8.A.4., and 656.361.8.A.5 Ordinance Code.

g) Vacates approximately 0.12 acre right-of-way, and 0.12 acre drainage easement found on the subject property; and,

h) Waives the Public Investment Policy to authorize a Completion Grant for the construction of a riverfront restaurant.

Additional Requirements of the City

In order to complete the McCoys Creek project, coordinated with the redevelopment of the Times-Union property, the City will be responsible for the daylighting and relocation of McCoy's Creek to a widened channel approximately 100 feet to the east of its current location which will allow for more efficient and economical construction, improve the drainage capabilities and resiliency of the entire creek and create better recreational opportunities for park visitors. In doing so, the City will also be responsible for filling the existing creek bed and removing the existing bulkheads. Further, the City will be responsible for the continuation of May Street under the Riverside Avenue down ramp to provide access to the park and the property being redeveloped by the Developer.

2. Demolition of existing McCoy's Creek, acquisition of land for relocation of McCoy's Creek, construction of the relocated McCoy's Creek, and construction of the May Street extension for access to the property utilize funding currently approved In the CIP and are part of the McCoys Creek project.

3. Funds for the Supplemental Payment for Land in the amount of \$1,719,320 to bring the purchase price up to appraised value will be requested under separate appropriation from the General Fund once the pre-conditions have been satisfied to allow park use of this surplus parcel.

4. The Restaurant Completion grant of up to \$750,000. is envisioned to be funded by the NB CRA provided sufficient funds are avaiable in the CRA in the year of completion. Funding will be appropriated in the annual CRA budget or by separate legislation in the fiscal year in which funds will be required.
