RESOLUTION 2021-797-A

A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMEMORATING THE LIFE AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF JOEL RAYMOND "RAY" MOORE AND EXTENDING CONDOLENCES TO HIS FAMILY AND FRIENDS; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 WHEREAS, Joel Raymond "Ray" Moore, a Jacksonville native and the 15 son of a long-time Jacksonville firefighter, graduated from Andrew 16 Jackson High School and, following college, returned to the school 17 as a teacher and coach; and

18 WHEREAS, following his teaching career, Mr. Moore was for many 19 years a successful State Farm insurance agent; and

20 WHEREAS, Ray Moore is best known to the general public as the 21 "father of the Veterans Memorial Wall" for his initiation and 22 leadership of the project to finance and construct a memorial to all 23 the Jacksonville citizens who gave their life in military service to 24 the country; and

WHEREAS, during his time as a student at Andrew Jackson High School, Mr. Moore became interested in a hand-lettered calligraphy certificate displaying the names of Andrew Jackson students who had died in World War II, given by the Class of 1947. He later found that the certificate had become water-damaged and had been removed for storage, and that planted the seed for his desire to appropriately memorialize veterans who made the ultimate sacrifice in a more 1

permanent and prominent way; and

2 WHEREAS, in the 1990s Ray Moore spent countless hours 3 researching and collecting the names of more than 1,700 service men and women who died in the line of duty from every Duval County high 4 school, and yet more countless hours raising funds and mobilizing 5 support for the construction of a wall inscribed with the names of 6 all those to be honored for their sacrifices. The wall was dedicated 7 in 1995 and ever since has been the focal point of the community's 8 9 ceremonies honoring those brave men and women; and

10 WHEREAS, the Council was saddened to hear of the recent passing 11 of Ray Moore, who has done so much for our community; now therefore 12 BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City hereby honors and commemorates the life and accomplishments of Joel Raymond "Ray" Moore and extends to his family, friends, and many admirers the City Council's sincere condolences on his passing. Ray Moore's dedication to a noble cause has left the community he loved with an indelible memorial both to the honor of the men and women who gave their lives for their country and to Mr. Moore himself.

20 Section 2. Requesting emergency passage upon introduction 15 21 pursuant to Council Rule 4.901. Emergency passage upon introduction 22 of this Resolution is requested to convey the community's sympathy 23 to Mr. Moore's family in a timely manner.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
