Introduced by Council Member Ferraro and amended by the Neighborhoods,

Community Services, Public Health and Safety Committee:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THEMAYOR AND SECRETARY CORPORATION TO EXECUTE Α THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH JACKSONVILLE UNIVERSITY TO RENEW THE CONTRACT FOR A THIRD FOR THE CONTINUING MANATEE ADDITIONAL YEAR PROTECTION STUDIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022, INCLUDING THE CONTINUING TASK FOR A BOATER SPEED ZONE COMPLIANCE STUDY, SUBJECT TO APPROPRIATION BY CITY COUNCIL; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville has engaged Jacksonville University to provide marine science support, particularly in developing and refining the City's Manatee Protection Plan; and

WHEREAS, the University's A. Quinton White, Ph.D., a highly regarded expert on marine mammals, especially manatees, has been the principal scientist under the contract with Jacksonville University; and

WHEREAS, conflict, such as the differing regulatory approaches to manatee protection and the debate over the status of the manatee, indicates the continuing need for marine science support; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized the contract with Dr. White through Ordinance 2018-540-E, which invoked Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code, to waive competitive solicitation and bidding due to Dr. White's expertise; and

renewals to the contract; and

WHEREAS, the City has exercised renewal options in Ordinances 2019-645-E and 2020-588-E and now desires to enter into a third renewal; and

WHEREAS, a revised Task 8 for a Boater Speed Zone Compliance Study (the "Study") was outlined in the first amendment to the contract, which was to be completed within Fiscal Year 2019/2020 for the amount of \$90,000.00; and

WHEREAS, due to lengthy discussions with the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission regarding the scope of work for the Study as required by the City of Jacksonville Manatee Protection Plan, 4th Edition, dated November 2017, and delays brought on by COVID-19 which disrupted the University's ability to perform the data collection for the Study, the Study was initiated in Fiscal Year 2019/2020, but not completed and the funds for the Study were carried over to Fiscal Year 2020/2021; and

WHEREAS, the collection of data for the Study was conducted in Fiscal Year 2020/2021, but the Study was not completed, because the funding is obligated, the funds will carry over to Fiscal Year 2021/2022, no additional funds will be needed for the Study in Fiscal Year 2021/2022, which will bring the total contract amount to \$450,000 (\$90,000.00 for the original contract (Fiscal Year 2018/2019) + \$90,000.00 for the first renewal (Fiscal Year 2019/2020) + \$90,000.00 for the Boater Speed Zone Compliance Study + \$90,000 for the second renewal (Fiscal Year 2020/2021) + \$90,000 for the third renewal (Fiscal Year 2021/2022)); and

WHEREAS, at its September 15, 2021 meeting, the Waterways Commission voted to recommend approval of the proposed contract renewal, including the completion of the Study; and

WHEREAS, the Council would like to exercise the third extension to renew the contract for an additional one-year renewal to September

30, 2022, and to include the continuation of work on the Study to its completion; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Authorizing the Mayor and Corporation Secretary to Execute a Third Amendment to the Contract for Continuing Manatee Protection Studies, dated October 4, 2018. Subject to appropriation by the City Council, the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are authorized to execute a Third Amendment to the contract with Jacksonville University to exercise the third one (1) year renewal of the contract term for the services of Dr. A. Quinton White and Dr. Gerard Pinto for continuing manatee protection studies in substantially the same form as contained in the document attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 1 labeled as "Revised Exhibit 1, Rev Contract, October 18, 2021 - NCSPHS".

Section 2. Oversight. The Planning and Development Department shall oversee the Study described herein.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
