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## ORDINANCE 2021-778-W

5 AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE CONFIRMATION OF THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF JASON R. TEAL AS THE 6 7 GENERAL COUNSEL PURSUANT TO SECTION 7.03 OF THE 8 CHARTER OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE; WAIVING COUNCIL RULE 4.1103 (CONFIRMATION OF THE GENERAL 9 10 COUNSEL), COUNCIL RULES, AS TO THE REQUIREMENT 11 THAT UPON INTRODUCTION OF ANY RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OR REAPPOINTMENT OF 12 THE GENERAL COUNSEL, LEGISLATIVE SERVICES SHALL 13 NOTIFY THE CLERK OF COURT, PROPERTY APPRAISER, 14 SHERIFF, SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS, TAX COLLECTOR 15 AND CHAIRPERSON OF THE DUVAL COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD 16 AND ENCOURAGE THEM TO PROVIDE ORAL OR WRITTEN 17 INPUT AND GUIDANCE AS TO THE FITNESS OF THE 18 APPOINTEE TO BE GENERAL COUNSEL; REQUESTING 19 EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING 20 21 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the selection of the General Counsel is governed by the City of Jacksonville Charter (the "Charter"), Section 7.03 (Selection and Term of the General Counsel); and

26 WHEREAS, in accordance therewith, following the resignation of 27 the former General Counsel Jason R. Gabriel on August 6, 2021, Mayor 28 Curry empaneled the General Counsel's Qualification Review Committee 29 consisting of the designee of the Jacksonville Bar Association 30 President, two former general counsels of the City and two members 31 of the Florida Bar Board of Governors; and WHEREAS, during the pendency of the vacancy, Mayor Curry appointed an acting General Counsel pursuant to Charter Section 7.05 (Vacancy) for a period not to exceed 90 days from the effective date of the vacancy on August 7, 2021 in order for there to be continuity and an orderly operation in the Office of General Counsel; and

6 WHEREAS, the 90-day period is scheduled to expire at the end of
7 November 4, 2021; and

8 WHEREAS, the General Counsel's Qualification Review Committee 9 commenced meeting in September 2021 and advertised for interested 10 candidates for the General Counsel position for two weeks; and

WHEREAS, on October 4, 2021, the General Counsel's Qualification Review Committee voted unanimously to strongly recommend Acting General Counsel Jason R. Teal be appointed as General Counsel; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Teal graduated with Honors from Florida State 15 University College of Law in 1998; he has been employed with the Office of General Counsel since October 2000, including as an 16 17 Assistant General Counsel from October 2000 to February 2010, when he was promoted to Chief of the Office's Regulatory Division; he 18 served as Regulatory Chief from February 2010 until November 2015, 19 20 when he was promoted to Deputy General Counsel over the Office's 21 Regulatory and Constitutional Law Department; and

22 WHEREAS, during his tenure with the Office of General Counsel, 23 Mr. Teal has represented clients from nearly every aspect and element 24 of the Consolidated City government and has participated in numerous 25 critical and significant matters involving and defending the Charter, 26 the Ordinance Code and the overall interests of the Consolidated 27 City; and

28 WHEREAS, Mayor Lenny Curry has found that the interests of the 29 Consolidated Government will be best served by appointing Mr. Teal 30 as General Counsel; and

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WHEREAS, in accordance with the process outlined in Charter

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Section 7.03, the Mayor filed Resolution 2021-770 seeking the
 Council's confirmation of the appointment of Jason R. Teal as General
 Counsel; and

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2021, in compliance with Council Rule
4.1101, Mr. Teal appeared in front of the Rules Committee and was
interviewed by the members of said Committee and visiting members of
Council; and

during its October 19<sup>th</sup> meeting 8 WHEREAS, and prior to 9 interviewing Mr. Teal, the Rules Committee discussed Council Rule 10 4.1103 (Confirmation of the General Counsel), which requires that upon introduction of any resolution confirming the appointment or 11 reappointment of the General Counsel, Legislative Services shall 12 notify the Clerk of Court, Property Appraiser, Sheriff, Supervisor 13 of Elections, Tax Collector and Chairperson of the Duval County School 14 15 Board and encourage them to provide oral or written input and guidance to the Rules Committee and any other committee considering said 16 17 appointment or reappointment, as to the fitness of the appointee to be General Counsel; and 18

WHEREAS, the Legislative Services Division confirmed that notice 19 20 to the Constitutional Officers and the Chair of the Duval County 21 School Board had not been provided prior to the October 19th Rules 22 Committee meeting, thus necessitating the subsequent filing of this 23 legislation at the request of the Rules Committee in order to waive 24 the aforementioned notice requirement in Council Rule 4.1103 and to 25 ensure the appointment of Jason R. Teal as General Counsel can be 26 acted upon in a timely manner prior to the expiration of the 90-day period outlined in Section 7.05(a) of the Charter; now therefore 27

28 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:
29 Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and
30 correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

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Waiver of Council Rule 4.1103 (Confirmation of 1 Section 2. 2 the General Counsel), Council Rules. Council Rule 4.1103 (Confirmation of the General Counsel), Part 11 (Appointments and 3 Confirmations), Chapter 4 (Procedures), Council Rules, is hereby 4 5 waived as to the requirement that upon the introduction of any resolution confirming the appointment or reappointment of the General 6 7 Counsel, Legislative Services shall notify the Clerk of Court, Property Appraiser, Sheriff, Supervisor of Elections, Tax Collector 8 9 and Chairperson of the Duval County School Board and encourage them 10 to provide input as to the fitness of the appointee to be General Counsel. The Legislative Services Division confirmed this notice was 11 not provided prior to the October 19th meeting of the Rules Committee. 12 This waiver is necessary to ensure Resolution 2021-770 confirming the 13 appointment of Jason R. Teal as General Counsel is acted upon prior 14 to the expiration of the 90-day period described in Section 7.05(a) 15 16 of the Charter on November 4, 2021.

17 Section 3. Requesting emergency passage upon introduction pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage upon 18 introduction of this Ordinance is requested. The nature of the 19 emergency is that section 7.05(a) of the Charter authorizes an acting 20 21 general counsel to be appointed for a maximum of 90 days from the 22 commencement of the vacancy. The former General Counsel's resignation 23 was on August 6, 2021, creating a vacancy as of August 7, 2021. The 90-day period expires at the end of November 4, 2021, requiring 24 passage of this Ordinance no later than the Council meeting on October 25 26, 2021. 26

27 Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 29 without the Mayor's signature.
