DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY/FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE PASS-THROUGH GRANT FUNDING DISTRIBUTED BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND FUNDED THROUGH THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021, TO BE USED IN PREPARING FOR, RESPONDING TO, RECOVERING FROM, AND MITIGATING AGAINST THE IMPACTS OF NATURAL AND MAN-MADE EMERGENCIES, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 21-122; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$13,926.00 in Emergency Management Performance pass-through grant funding from the Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency distributed by the Florida Department of Emergency Management and funded through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. These funds will be used to assist the City of Jacksonville in preparing for, responding to, recovering from, and mitigating the impacts of natural and man-made emergencies as more particularly described herein. The grant period commences July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. No City match is required.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund the purchase of five (5) satellite phone (portable) kits with Florida SatNet Service to support the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department Emergency Preparedness Division's interoperable communications capabilities. In addition, grant funds will be used to procure twenty (20) shelter signs for Duval County's Emergency Operations Center. A copy of the Federally-Funded Subaward Grant Agreement (Agreement Number: G0335) providing the terms and conditions relative to receipt and expenditure of the grant funds has been placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services.

Section 3. Oversight. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department, Emergency Preparedness Division shall oversee administration of the grant described herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
