Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$444,964.86 in funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency, funded through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program and approved by the Florida Division of Emergency Management. The Department of Public Works will provide oversight. The 2020-2026 CIP is amended to provide funding for the project.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to support the Public Works Department with improvement of the drainage of McCoy's Creek channel, in addition to road and bridge flood protection. The grant period commences January 22, 2021 to April 30, 2022. The FEMA grant will fund surveying, engineering, design, plan preparation, permitting and bidding construction for the project.
