Bill Summary: This ordinance establishes an honorary street designation and associated roadway markers in Council District 12 for Captain Thomas M. Barber, a Fallen Fire and Rescue Officer who died in the Line of Duty in June of 2021.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is for Manor Drive to receive an honorary street designation for Captain Thomas M. Barber extending from Timuquana Road to Old Timuquana Road in Council District 12. This bill also provides for the installation of two honorary roadside markers to be located in appropriate locations on the designated roadway, and waiver of section 745.105 (I)(2) which requires that the honoree be deceased for at least 5 years. The Chief of Legislative Services is requested to send a copy of the enacted legislation once enacted to The Planning and Development Department for processing, implementation, and cordiantion with 911 Emergency, Fire and Rescue Department, the Post Office, and other affected agencies.
