funding above The represents an appropriation \$337,500.00 in Fire And Rescue Grant funding from the Department of Homeland Security/Port Security Grant Program distributed by the Department of Homeland Security / Federal Department of Emergency Management and funded through the Department of Homeland Security / Federal Department of Emergency Management FY2021 Port Security Program and an additional appropriation of \$112,500.00 from the City. These funds will be used to assist the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department with purchasing one aluminum, open-ocean and inshore, CBRNE capable fire suppression hazmat response boat. The grant period commences September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2024.

Section 2. Purpose.
