11 THE CITY) TO PURCHASE ONE (1) 37' ALUMINUM,  
12 OPEN-OCEAN AND INSHORE, CBRNE CAPABLE FIRE  
13 SUPPRESSION HAZMAT RESPONSE BOAT, AS INITIATED  
14 BY Revised B.T. 22-009; PURPOSE OF  
15 APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY  
16 JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT;  
17 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,  
21 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
22 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
23 listed in subsection (b):

1 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

2 The funding above represents an appropriation of  
3 \$337,500.00 in Fire And Rescue Grant funding from the  
4 Department of Homeland Security/Port Security Grant  
5 Program distributed by the Department of Homeland Security  
6 / Federal Department of Emergency Management and funded  
7 through the Department of Homeland Security / Federal  
8 Department of Emergency Management FY2021 Port Security  
9 Grant Program and an additional appropriation of  
10 \$112,500.00 from the City. These funds will be used to  
11 assist the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department with  
12 purchasing one aluminum, open-ocean and inshore, CBRNE  
13 capable fire suppression hazmat response boat. The grant  
14 period commences September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2024.

15 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
16 Section 1 is to support the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department  
17 with purchasing one aluminum, open-ocean and inshore, CBRNE capable  
18 fire suppression hazmat response boat. A copy of the Federally-  
19 Funded FY2021 Port Security Grant Program (Grant Number: EMW-2021-  
20 PU-00446) providing the terms and conditions relative to receipt and  
21 expenditure of the grant funds has been placed **On File** with the Office  
22 of Legislative Services.

23 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue  
24 Department, Emergency Preparedness Division shall oversee  
25 administration of the grant described herein.

26 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
27 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
28 without the Mayor's signature.
