Presentation on Procurement Bill 2023-20

Lawsikia Hodges, OGC, gave a presentation on 2023-20 (first introduced by CM Cumber in January 2023) and she explained how it revises the City's Procurement Code. Ms. Hodges provided an historical overview of Jacksonville's consolidation and the role of centralized services. At the time of consolidation in 1968, central services included the motor pool, personnel, communications, legal, public relations and purchasing.

Ms. Hodges described CM Cumber's goals when working on the drafting of this bill. She said that the intent was to streamline the process and scope of the award committees and move toward the utilization of modern procurement technologies. Additionally, the bill seeks to add more transparency/accountability to contract administration. With the changes made through this bill, the Jacksonville Procurement Code will be referred to as the Jax P-Code, and the award committees will change to one (Jacksonville Procurement Awards Committee - JPAC) instead of 3 with revised membership to include the Directors of Finance and Public Works, and the City's Risk Manager. The Chief of Procurement will provide administrative support, with legal support provided by OGC.

CM Johnson asked about the Ombudsman and whether there is a conflict because they report to the Chief of Procurement since they mediate contract disputes between the City and suppliers.

CM Boylan distributed a handout with a suggested change to the Public Comment portion of council meetings, for the committee to consider and possibly take action on at a later date. The possible public comment changes may be that attendees who submit their comment cards before 5:00 pm get the full 3 minutes to speak, and those after get a decreased time as time permits. Or a change could be made to accept cards up to 30 minutes prior to the Public Comment portion and the first batch of speakers receive 3 minutes and the balance of time will be parsed among the remaining speakers.

CM Freeman led a discussion about ethics and former council members lobbying the council after their terms, and how that relates to a prohibition of such for 2 years after their term ends. For his example, if a former council member has been appointed by the Mayor to direct a department and is meeting with council members prior to the council vote on the appointment, per CM Freeman, the action is lobbying, in that the individual is trying to affect the outcome of the vote and if approved they would receive a salary. He suggested sending the issue to the state ethics commission for an advisory opinion. Kirby Oberdorfer, Ethics Director, deferred questions to OGC.

Lawsikia Hodges, OGC, said there are 2 state laws, a constitutional ban on lobbying for 6 years with a an exception for public employees acting in the normal scope of their duties; and a 2 year ban state statute level prohibiting on representing another party before your former agency. They discussed the former council member Lori Boyer example, wherein when she was first named CEO of DIA, for 2 years she could not come before council to advocate for legislation but she could come when invited to answer questions on various issues. Ms. Hodges said that Mr. Ferraro can meet with council members individually since he's advocating for himself in the Neighborhoods Director appointment process. Ms. Hodges said the final arbiter for this question is the state ethics commission, and that the request has to come from a body not an individual member or committee, the full council. She said that the interim general counsel is working to schedule a meeting with CM Freeman to discuss this, and CM Freeman said that he could watch the video as it has all been put on the table during this meeting. Ms. Hodges informed the group that the minimum turnaround time for a state ethics commission opinion is 3 months. CM Freeman said that is the direction the inquiry is going, assuming the passage of a resolution from council.
