There was a lengthy discussion about this bill, which would permit the Duval County School Board to place a referendum, regarding a half cent sales surtax to fund capital improvements, on the ballot in November of 2019. There were questions about the details of the school board's master plan, the costs, timeline, selection process and the effect of low voter turnout. CM Diamond expressed concerns about enrollment numbers and whether charter schools receiving a share of potential funds. CM Carlucci emphasized the urgency of allowing the public to vote on the sales tax, as many school building are in disrepair and some have dysfunctional air conditioning systems. CM Morgan supported CM Carlucci in voting against the deferral, noting that the school board's authority should not be superseded by City Council. CP Wilson said he will be holding a noticed joint meeting with school board members and council members to further discuss the issues.
