There was a lengthy discussion regarding this bill. Brian Hughes, Mayor's Office, was in attendance to speak about the ongoing process to address 2020 Census marketing. Mr. Hughes said that the Planning Department has been working for several months on this project, making this resolution unnecessary. CM Diamond motioned for a withdrawal, but there was no second. CM Priestly Jackson emphasized the importance of an accurate census count (which is tied to representation and federal funding) particularly for minorities, and she requested a written status report from the Administration regarding the current Census efforts. CM Dennis was in attendance to speak about Census marketing efforts at the state level and asked that the bill be deferred to allow for more input from state legislators. CM Morgan spoke about the importance of honoring colleagues' deferral requests, and deferred the bill until next cycle. CM Dennis agreed to work with Stephanie Burch, Deputy CAO, to get the status report referenced by CM Priestly Jackson.
