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CM Newby had some concerns about the bill. He asked how Feeding Northeast Florida obtains their food. Susan King, President and CEO of Feeding Northeast Florida, stated that the food comes from a recovery program through over 200 grocery stores. The organzation buys from farming programs and other entities in order to not be buying near end of date products and having fresh produce. CM Newby said that he had an issue with the bill because he wants fresh food to be accessible in the area, rather than recovery food. Kirk Wendland, Office of Economic Development, clarified the bill will appropriate money into the Mobile Markets Program and a future bill will appropriate a portion of the funds to Feeding Northeast Florida to fund the Delivery Inititatives Program.

There were many members of the community that spoke during the public comment period against the location bring acquired. The main issues with the location are that it is far from the community that would utalize a new library, near a landfill, not in walking or biking distance and that those in the community highlighted other locations which they believe would be a lot better and easier to access. Brian Hughes, Mayor's Office, emphasized that the acquition of the area and planned development is a sign of more development to come in that area. CM Priestly Jackson voiced concern that the distance of the library from the public schools in the area will create an underutilization of a valuable resource in the community.
