COMMENTARY: CMs Gaffney, Ferraro, Cumber, and Becton held a dialogue clarifying the specifics of the bill. Susan Grandin of OGC provided additional clarification of this bill and passed out a memo from Jason Teal of OGC confirming that the C&D Debris fee is appropriate. Andrew King of J.B Coxwell Contracting provided additional commentary and clarification. Chairman Freeman noted that CM Dennis was not present and that because CM Dennis is the sponsor of the bill that it would typically be deferred. Ultimately, it was decided to take up the bill since the issue has been present for a long time in multiple committees and OGC has affirmed the current fee structure's legality.
