There was a lengthy discussion about this bill, which failed to be approved by the Finance Committee with a 2-5 vote. CM Dennis was in attendance to speak about the need for this appropriation, which will provide funds for independent legal counsel for City Council in the event of a JEA recapitalization event. CM Diamond said that the bill is premature and that council should wait until after a firm is selected to appropriate the funds. CM DeFoor said that it would be more prudent to do it in advance of firm selection. CP Wilson spoke in support of the bill, as did CM Newby. Noting that JEA has already secured multiple law firms and subject matter experts, CM Priestly Jackson was supportive as well. If the funds are not needed, they will be reallocated through legislation.

Discussion about 2019-413

There was some discussion about this bill, which appoints Dr. Pomm to the Opioid Abuse Prevention Committee and has been postponed for several cycles. An informal draft opinion from the Florida Commission on Ethics found no conflict of interest. CM Diamond thanked Dr. Pomm for all of his work on this issue and made a motion to waive the residency requirement and amend the resolution to recognize Dr. Pomm's significant business interest in Jacksonville, where he has worked since 1992.

Legislative Counsel Scope of Services, Jason Gabriel -Office of General Counsel

There was a discussion about the engagement letter, scope and services and selection process for outside legal counsel for City Council in preparation for a potential JEA recapitalization event. Jason Gabriel, General Counsel, was present to take questions and offer a framework for the scope of services. CM Boylan provided a version with his added content, CM Diamond also worked with Mr. Gabriel on adding to the scope. CM DeFoor had some added content as well. City Council will be accepting applications from law firms who offer expertise in the areas of corporate transactions, mergers and acquisitions; environmental matters pertaining to public utilities, water and regulation; labor and collective bargaining' procurement. Mr. Gabriel will integrate the suggestions from the committee members and then disseminate the edited scope of services to all council members. There will then be a period of application submissions and council workshops to address any issues related to a potential JEA privatization/sale.
