CM Dennis was in attendance to speak on behalf of this bill, which would amend Council Rule 4.301 in order to add a second public comment period to the council meeting format. CM Dennis said that the additional time period would provide constituents with more time to speak about legislation prior to it being voted upon. CM DeFoor agreed that it makes more sense for the public to voice their opinions before council voting. CM Newby said that sometimes the public comments are not germane to actual legislation, which slows the process of council business. CM Diamond noted that there are numerous other methods by which constituents may voice their views on policies- such as email, social media, phone calls, and making appointments with council members. CM Priestly Jackson said that perhaps a noticed meeting would be beneficial to examine the council meeting format, CM DeFoor made a motion for withdrawal, with the caveat that the bill be revised and then re-introduced. CM Carlucci made a motion for deferral to allow time to amend the bill. The majority of the committee supported the withdrawal over the deferral and then voted to approve the motion for withdrawal 6-1, with CM Boylan in opposition.

Mr. Grey told CM Morgan that he stepped down from the DIA Board before submitting the garage privatization bid to avoid perceptions of impropriety, and as such CM Morgan believed that his decisions on the JEA Board will be ethical and unbiased.
