The Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency (Safer) Grant comes from filling out a civil rights evaluation and submitting it for approval of the grant. This is to make sure the Fire and Rescue Department is not violating anyone's civil rights. The hiring will take place in March and the grant is a 75/25 match grant with \$2,990,280 coming from the United States Department of Homeland Security and \$747,570 coming from the City's Fund Balance.
