Presentation: Coronavirus Update

Samantha Epstein, Director of Communications at the Florida Department of Health, gave an update on the coronavirus which is a new illness causing respiratory issues. The virus was first detected in China and is now in other countries including the United States. There are currently 88 cases being monitored in Florida and 2 confirmed cases in Florida. There are no cases in Jacksonville. Testing is now available through the State lab and people that feel they might have the virus are encouraged to self isolate. CM Salem asked about test kits and if they are available locally. Ms. Epstein said that they are available through the State lab in Tallahassee and those test kits will be sent to local hospitals. Brian Hughes, Mayor's Office, gave information in regards to a cruise line which disembarked in Jacksonville and a crew member had symptoms similar to the virus. This crew member was taken to UF Health and put into isolation until it was determined the patient was not at enough risk to need to be quarentined.
