Chair Freeman called the meeting to order with a recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance. Chair Freeman explained the procedures for working through this virtual meeting. He stated that Vice Chair Salem would move the actionable bills and CM bowman would provide the second to the motion.

Paige Johnston, Office of General Counsel, provided clarification of the "unanimous consent" concept for virtual meetings covered under Ordinance 2020-200 regarding the temporary virtual meetings. Ms. Johnston explained that bills with an amendment will be considered to have unanimous consent. If a Councilmember has questions about the amendment or wants to not pass the motion, they were instructed to click the "raise hand" option within the Zoom technology that is being used to conduct the virtual meetings.

JEA Update regarding COVID-19: Kurt Wilson, JEA Interim Vice President and Chief Government Affairs Officer, provided an update on JEA's response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Mr. Wilson gave a brief overview of what JEA is doing to help customers during this pandemic, including waiving late fees, not disconnecting customers for non-payment, waiving third party credit card fees for customers, and he encouraged customers struggling to pay their JEA bill to call (904) 665-6000 to work with JEA to find a solution. Mr. Wilson reminded customers that hurricane season starts June 1st and encouraged customers to remember to prepare for hurricane season despite the current pandemic. He discussed the recently passed rebate for \$27,000,000.00 that will give each JEA customer a roughly \$25.00 credit on their May bill. Mr. Wilson closed by talking about the measures that JEA are taking to safeguard their employees and customers including the closure of public facilities and social distancing measures. CMs Ferraro, Boylan, and Bowman provided their support of Mr. Wilson. CM Bowman asked about future measure to assist customers during the COVID-19 pandemic. Mr. Wilson talked about several ideas to assist customers including the possibility of some type of loan program for customers and small businesses.
