Susan Grandin, Office of General Counsel, explained the substitute. Ms. Grandin detailed the bill, which will amend the municipal code. This will put the City in lock step with the State. Chapter 5.18 will allow the enforcement mechanism to fall under the Neighborhoods Department. This also clarifies the trust fund which will be called the derelict vessels and floating structures fund. CM Ferraro talked about the issues in regards to the amounts of derelict vessels and floating structures in the waterways. CM Pittman echoed the importance of this enforcement. CM Becton asked for clarification on the differences between 2020-559 and 2020-589. Paige Johnston, Office of General Counsel, explained what 2020-559 aims to do with its legislation - adding a fee for boaters which would go towards funding the repairs of docks and ramps. Ms. Grandin explained the history of this bill 2020-589 and what it aims to do. The bill aims to clarify the floating structure and derelict vessels mechanism for enforcement as well as the funding that can be received to go to these issues. CMs Diamond, Bowman, White, Freeman, Becton and Pittman asked to be added as co-sponsors to the bill.
