COVID-19 Update from the Health Department

Dr. Pauline Rolle, Director of Florida Health Department of Duval County, gave the Covid-19 update. There has been an increase in cases and the Health Department over the next weeks will be monitoring the amount of cases following Thanksgiving weekend. The Health Department will also be monitoring the schools. The timeline for the first round of vaccines is the end of December and more are expected in the beginning of next year. The first round of vaccines will most likely be given to the hospitals, as well as long term care facilities and first responders will also be most likely be in the first group.

CM Bowman asked about protocols for when someone is sick in a workplace. Dr. Rolle said there are CDC guidelines to cleaning work areas. There are Covid-19 approved cleaning products and to do a deep cleaning and close the offices for 24 hours. CM Bowman asked about the importance of plexiglass and if it is helpful. Dr. Rolle said that Covid-19 transmits when someone is positive and under 6 feet away of someone else for 15 minutes. CM Pittman asked about the number of cases in schools. Dr. Rolle said the numbers in schools have continued to rise. Most of the cases come from outside the schools. Dr. Rolle said she will send links to the CDC guidelines to the City Council.

CM Becton said that the Finance Chair has talked about raising taxes and he is uncomfortable with that when there are dollars to fund the needs in Jacksonville.

CM Salem said the emergency is because of the Council break in December and with this emergency it will not waste another 6 weeks before the implementation. CM Salem said he planned to bring this up at the Social Justice Committee 10 days ago but it was canceled due to Covid-19.

CM Pittman said she has concerns about the process in funding. CM Salem said the Social Justice Chair is supportive of the bill. CM Freeman said he is supportive. Phillip Peterson, Auditor's Office, said the amendment is just technical in its changes. CM Freeman suggested an amendment that would add language stating that the money being appropriated from the Social Justice Committee's portion of the available funds and not from the portion allocated for individual council members to propose uses.

Peggy Sidman, OGC, explained that the funds are from the budget and all in one account. CM Salem said that there is not an omnibus bill of all Social Justice projects. CM Freeman said he was not aware of there not being an omnibus bill and he removed his amendment from consideration.

CM Becton said these funds are coming from the JIA CRA. CM Diamond supports the bill but stressed the need for saving money for next year's budget. Phillip Peterson clarified that there is \$2.8 million in the budget for this funding. CM Pittman asked if Suzbacher will continue the project if the pilot project is successful. CM Salem said that if this is successful there will be companies open to being a part of this project.

Cidy Funkhouser, President and CEO of the Suzbacher Center, explained the mental health program and what groups are part of the project which will help to take the burden off jails. This will be a misdemeanors program with offenders that have mental health issues and will help those in need of mental health

services help instead of jail. Ms. Funkhouser said that a similar project in Miami has had a high success rate and allowed them to shut down jails by focusing on the mental health needs of the offender. There needs to be 7 to 8 months of data on this program and there should be a lot of interested investors into the program. There is a 90% success rate with the program.
