Actions of the 10/12/20 Special Investigatory Committee on JEA Matters regarding issuing subpoenas

**Voice Vote 4-3 (Boylan, Newby, Pittman opposed)** 

Subpoena process discussion - JEA Special Investigatory Committee

CM Carlucci made a motion to subpoenaTim Baker and several of his business entities. CM Priestly Jackson discussed the SIC charge to recommend legislative changes in regard to JEA, not launch a criminal investigation, but to consider ethical conflicts in regards to contracts and or consultants for the City and independent authorities etc. Mr. Gabriel said if the Rules Committee votes in the affirmative then subpoenas may be issued within few days, then served to the other party, then there is a deadline for a response, November 16 in accordance with the next SIC meeting. Noncompliance would mean council could pass an emergency resolution with an order to comply, with 2/3 votes. Council as a whole would have to decide how to enforce it, and give one more chance to comply before going to court or the State Attorney's Office.

CM Boylan asked, at what cost to what end, indicating the SIC goal was not to get anyone but just make sure it doesn't happen again.

CM DeFoor asked for Mr. Busey, outside counsel, to answer questions about the subpoena. Mr. Busey said the rationale for the subpoena is to find out what happened and to prevent it from repeating, and that the facts indicate that Mr. Baker was associated with multiple parties creating ethical and possibly procurement conflicts. Mr. Baker has thus far not produced his contract with FPL or other documents.

CM Newby expressed concerns about the cost and questioned what the point is, saying he doesn't believe council's job is to subpoenas private folks.

CM Dennis asked about the timeline, and said that council should know what happened, and that he supports subpoenas to gather the truth.

CM Carlucci spoke about the ethical breaches he believes were committed by Mr. Baker, and the importance of making legislative safeguards to prevent it from happening again.

CM Pittman said she was worried about cost too, and prevention.

CM Priestly Jackson spoke about integrity and the importance of fair competition, and the need to have all available evidence.

Council Members Cumber, Gaffney, Salem, White, Bowman, Freeman and Diamond said they wouldn't support the subpoena, noting the cost, the lack of necessity, and the presence of enough information to make the appropriate legislative changes.

The Rules Committee voted 4 to 3 to subpoena Mr. Baker, as well as several of his consulting firms (CMs Dennis, Priestly Jackson, DeFoor and Carlucci in the affirmative; CMs Newby, Boylan, Pittman in opposition).
