### SUB(TEU)/APPROVE

CM Boylan gave a presentation about JEA employment matters, procurement and compensation as related to work in the JEA workshops. The bill adds clarity to the Charter, and: designates that only the managing director may have an employment contract which is approved by the board, and some aspects of the pension/deferred compensation plan, specifies terms for bonuses, budget line item to reflect bonuses to council in budget process.

Lawsikia Hodges, OGC, talked about procurement and code changes in this bill related to the sale of JEA so that it may not effectively sell itself through procurement. Ms. Hodges said this bill makes so JEA procurement code will only be able to amended by the JEA Board, not the CEO. The bill, among other things, also requires an annual review and procurement report; and that all senior-level employees, including the managing director and senior-level officers, directors and managers of JEA, be trained by the Office of General Counsel, in consultation with the Ethics Office, at least annually.

CM DeFoor, Newby, Pittman, and Priestly Jackson commended CM Boylan for his diligent work on this bill.
