Sheryl Johnson, Founder and President of Hearts For Minds. shared her personal story of loss which prompted her to create the organization (her son suffered from depression and lost his life to an accidental overdose). CM Freeman also introduced Tony Washington, a coach and former football player, who also experienced a period of serious depression and survived a suicide attempt. The funds for the awareness campaign were appropriated in the last fiscal budget and the campaign itself strives to connect those in need with mental health resources and assistance.

Discussion: Legislative Recommendations of the Special Investigatory Committee on JEA Matters

The committee members discussed the legislative recommendations from the Special Investigatory Committee on JEA Matters, which includes issues in the areas of procurement, council investigative authority, compensation programs, and ethics and transparency.

CM Boylan said that the Office of General Counsel should review the recommendations and see which ones already have relevant rules and procedures and which do not. CM Dennis expressed concerns about the procurement process used by OGC to retain outside counsel. It was suggested that the recommendations for procurement be forwarded to that department, and the compensation portion to the Auditor's Office, and the ethics portion to the Ethics Office, for consideration. Peggy Sidman, Office of General Counsel, said she will provide the legislation related to procuring outside counsel to the committee members. The group concluded that there needs to be more discussion about the report recommendations at the next committee meeting.
