# AMEND(FINANCE)/APPROVE

There was a lengthy discussion regarding this bill, which would permit filing legislation separate from the annual budget bill if the Council adopts an increased annual salary over the prior fiscal year. CM Diamond was in attendance to speak on behalf of the bill and said that his intent is to allow full transparency and public participation in the salary increase process. CM Diamond expressed opposition to the amendment from the Finance Committee, which adds language to state that "each council member shall submit in writing a notification with the Council Secretary as to their election for salary placement for the upcoming fiscal year prior to October 1 of the affected fiscal year. The notifications shall be published each year on the City Council website". CM Carlucci said that it should be left to individual council members, who all experience different levels of financial security, to decide whether or not to accept pay increases. He also commented on the lack of stringent transparency when it comes to things like economic incentives for deals with developers. CM Dennis commented that the salaries for constitutional officers are derived from a formula at the state level, and is then divided in half for Jacksonville CMs because it is technically a part time position. He also spoke about maintaining a level playing field for council candidates, which includes fair compensation so it is not necessary to be independently wealthy to run for office. CM Priestly Jackson noted that the state has had a process in place for salary formulations since 1983, and that separating salaries from the rest of the City budget creates issue politically, and that there are waiver options available as needed due to situational financial constraints (like recessions etc.).

CM Boylan said that council members should be compensated fairly for their

service, regardless of if they are retired or currently employed elsewhere. CM Newby shared his personal story of opting to retire from his professional career when he decided to run for council, so as to fully direct his time to council work (he is not reliant upon his council salary, as he receives a pension from his former employer).
