# Presentation from JAXPORT to be provided by Nick Primrose, Chief of Regulatory Compliance

Al Ferraro was called to speak.

Nick Primrose, Chief of Regulatory Compliance at JAXPORT, went over a PowerPoint presentation detailing the work being done at JAXPORT. Mr. Primrose talked about their ability to manage through supply chain issues and covid-19 without having any congestion. JAXPORT is a port of significance which mean military cargo and other important cargo moves through the port. Mr. Primrose talked about the harbor deepening project which will allow for more vessels to travel along the waterways. Mr. Primrose talked about the usage of cleaner marine fuels and the port's goals around environmental stewardship. Mr. Primrose outlined the places JAXPORT is looking to expand to in the next few years.
