There was some discussion regarding this resolution. CM Cumber expressed frustration with sponsors not coming to explain their bills in committee, and with what she perceives to be the excess of resolutions without impact. She and CM Priestly Jackson also said they were not supportive of mentioning ongoing criminal investigations in legislation. CM Bowman and CM DeFoor concurred. It was mentioned that in the bill text the incorrect neighborhood was used, Riverside instead of Brooklyn. CM Diamond spoke in support of the bill and for law enforcement in general. He proposed an amendment to correct the neighborhood error, which failed 3-3. There was talk of deferral, but the Chair was not so inclined. There was a motion to move the bill and a second, and the bill failed with a 1-5 vote.
