There was some discussion on this bill, which increases the distance required for rezoning notices for affected property owners from 350 feet to 500 feet. CM Diamond expressed his opposition because he feels the change will add complications to the development process and act as a deterrent. Bill Killingsworth, Director of Planning and Development, explained that the cost for notices is roughly \$7 per notice (labor and materials). He also explained the three manners of notifications, via mail, road signage and publishing in a local newspaper.

CM Ferraro said that this bill was drafted in response to residents who claimed they never received notices for rezoning projects in their neighborhoods. CM Newby asked how the increased distance would guarantee that all folks would receive notices.

CM Priestly Jackson said she supports the bill and wants to keep neighbors as informed of potential rezonings as possible.
