Paige Johnston, Ethics Office, explained the bill, which amends Section 602.1001, Chapter 602 (Ethics Code), to allow the City's Ethics Director to set the time for mandatory ethics training to be completed by elected officials following the certification of their election and to issue a digital "confirmation" of the completion of that training rather than a digital "certificate." This change would make the certification process less cumbersome on staff.

CM Priestly Jackson noted that she did not agree with the portion of the bill that deletes the reference to receiving joint approval for the timing of the mandatory training by the General Counsel. She proposed a floor amendment to retain the OGC language, but change it to "notification" rather than with the "concurrence" of the General Counsel. CM Priestly Jackson's floor amendment was approved unanimously (6-0) by the committee.

• DIA has calculated ROIs of 0.50 (Historic Improvements) and 7.64 (New Construction Improvements) over a 20-year period, based on a proposed adjustment to the DPRP funding structure that DIA will be recommending. The ROI calculation does not include the \$2,500,000 loan from the Jacksonville Housing Finance Authority.
