Phillip Peterson, Auditor's Office, explained the amendment.

Beth Mixson, Public Service Grant Council, spoke about the changes recommended in this bill. She said that the changes will increase transparency while decreasing members' workloads, and make the scoring process more efficient.

CM Boylan asked about creating tiered grant awards like the Cultural Council, so that more organizations may qualify for funding.

CM Clark-Murray asked about quorum issues. Ms. Mixson said that the vacant seats are within the purview of the Mayor and Council to fill, and that decreasing the required scorers from 5 to 3 will better distribute the hefty workload. Dr. Grass, Chief of Grants & Contract Compliance, said that the scoring process outlined in this bill is in keeping with how other grants are scored by the City and elsewhere.

CM Cumber spoke on behalf of this bill, which clarifies what forms of holiday decorations sexual offenders and sexual predators are prohibited from displaying at their homes in an effort to minimize or prevent attacks on children while also conforming to First Amendment rights. She also spoke about the recent lawsuit and investigation into Douglas Anderson School of the Arts, and said she has requested that Superintendent Greene and the DCSB Chair come to speak to the committee about it. CM Ferraro asked if the holiday displays were already forbidden under state law.

Craig Feiser, OGC, talked about a federal lawsuit last year regarding displays and about how this bill fills in any holes in the state statute, particularly relating to enforcement. He noted that JSO is in support of the bill.

CVP Salem asked about the offender registry, which is publicly available online and shows addresses of registered sexual offenders/predators. He also asked about requiring sexual offenders/predators to place identifying signs in their yards as a warning to children. Mr. Feiser said that such signs do not comply with the First Amendment.
