Curtis Hart spoke on behalf of this bill, which reduces the Construction and Demolition Debris Recycling Facility recycling requirement to 51%. Mr. Hart said that the market for recycled construction debris is flat, and that the 2024 requirement of 87% is unreasonable.

CM Diamond shared the history of the bill and how the reduced recycling requirement will enable the facilities to continue to provide services to the city and to stay in business.
