Trista Carraher, Auditor's Office, explained the substitute.

CM Carlucci reviewed the history of the bill, and the demolition of the old Ford Motor Company assembly plant. He spoke about the value of preserving historical buildings. The Restore Endangered Historic Adaptable Buildings (REHAB) Trust Fund would provide grants to incentivize the repair, rehabilitation and restoration of income-producing or mixed-use historic buildings or historic buildings owned by not-for-profit corporations, located throughout the city, excluding downtown.

CM Diamond expressed opposition for using City funds to preserve buildings, advocating for free market solutions.

CM Becton asked about the recurrence of funds year to year.

CM Priestly Jackson shared her support for the bill and asked to be added as a co-sponsor.

CM Boylan suggested adding a City match component to the grant awards.
